Greetings from the brass faculty at Stetson University! We are looking forward to meeting each of you and working closely with you during the week! We are planning a variety of performing opportunities that will provide you with new and interesting playing experiences!

  - (1) a daily schedule for the week,
  - (2) a "What to Bring to Camp" list,
  - (3) Directions to the Emily Hall dormitory,
  - (4) Rules and Regulations for all Brass Camp participants
  - (5) Student Honors Recital requirements: **PLEASE** email me the title and composer of the piece you will be playing for your audition!!!!
  - (6) **Informed Consent Form**: **PLEASE** fill out and bring with you to the check-in period at the dorm. This form is **ABSOLUTELY** essential in order to participate in the camp! **ALL** students must have one on file.
  - (7) Audition music for ensemble placement. **ALL** students will play a short placement audition. The music is also available online on our web page. The audition will be very informal and is used primarily to help us determine the types of performing groups that will best benefit the student.

Although we would prefer having your account paid in full by Monday, June 10, if necessary, the balance of your account may be payable by **check, money order, or cash ONLY** when you check in at the dorm (Emily Hall) on Monday, June 17th. Credit cards cannot be used for payment of your balance at the dorm! Check-in time at the dorm will be between 9:00 – 11:00 AM on Monday, June 17th. This includes all commuting students as well. Each student will receive a folder for the week, room keys, meal ticket and locker assignment upon checking in at the dorm. Placement auditions for **all** students and the Honors Recital auditions will start promptly at 1:00, so please plan to arrive early enough to get settled into your room and have enough time to go over to the music building to warm up and practice before your audition. **(Lunch WILL be provided this year.)** Parents are requested to leave immediately after getting your child settled into the dorm room. Counselors and staff will be present in the dorms at all times.
