The Accelerated Bachelor's to MBA program enables Stetson undergraduate students of any major to transition seamlessly from their bachelor's degree into the STEM-designated Master of Business Administration, saving both time and money.

During your senior year, you can take two designated Stetson courses that may count as general electives toward your bachelor's degree and as MBA Foundations for the MBA program, enabling you to use your existing undergraduate scholarships and financial aid.

You may complete the remaining ten MBA courses entirely online. An in-person option is available for students who prefer a more traditional classroom experience with face-to-face interaction with faculty, colleagues, and coursework.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS >>

- Stetson junior pursuing any major with a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must have two general elective courses remaining in undergraduate studies
- Complete the Accelerated Bachelor's to MBA Form for approval
- · Submit an application for admission to Stetson's MBA program in last undergraduate semester

PREPARING YOU FOR SUCCESS >>>

Stetson MBA students begin the program with two foundation courses that cover key concepts in finance, accounting, statistics, and modeling. These courses provide the essential business background needed to succeed in the MBA core curriculum, where faculty expand on this knowledge with advanced topics to further develop your business expertise and decision-making skills.

In the Accelerated Bachelor's to MBA pathway, undergraduate students take SOBA 406 (Foundations of Business Analytics) and SOBA 407 (Foundations of Accounting and Finance), which are cross listed with their graduate equivalents, SOBA 506 and SOBA 507. Undergraduate students who earn a B or better in one or both courses may waive the corresponding MBA course requirement, reducing the twelve-course program to as few as ten graduate courses.
