Our curriculum will prepare you to be a molecular biologist by engaging in inquiry-based and student-driven courses and authentic lab experiences. As a student enrolled in molecular, cellular biology and genetics, you will receive a unique, intensive lab experience leading to improved technical proficiency that has aided recent graduates to obtain competitive admission into post-graduate programs and secure jobs in health-related fields.

With a major in molecular and cellular biology, you will likely gain an interest in attending post-graduate programs since our curriculum incorporates many pre-requisites for medical school and graduate school.

The culmination of the program includes a three-course series research capstone project where you propose a research question, perform experiments and analyze acquired data and disseminate research findings in an oral and poster presentation.

After completing the project, you will present your research at our daylong symposium, Stetson Showcase. You may also have the opportunity to present your results at a regional scientific meeting like the Florida Undergraduate Research Conference.
