- Facilitated Panel:** These are Q&A sessions with co-panelists assembled by a primary presenter. A panel discussion should involve 3 or more individuals offering various perspectives on a topic. Facilitated Panels are especially good for a problem-oriented approach to a topic wthat encourages new perspectives and solutions.
- Birds of a Feather:** Birds of a Feather sessions (or BoFs) are informal gatherings of like-minded individuals who wish to discuss a topic without a pre-planned agenda. BoFs are a great place to spark collaborative work!
